In many countries, academic freedom is protected in law through legislation or through a constitutional guarantee. In the European Union, it is grounded in the EU's Charter of Fundamental Rights and in individual state constitutions (such as Estonia, Finland, Germany and Greece). In the United States, academic freedom for public post-secondary institutions is primarily anchored in the right to freedom of speech contained in the First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution.
