The current practice of screening for HCM involves bringing Bengal cats to a board certified veterinary cardiologist where an echocardiogram is completed. Bengal cats which are used for breeding should be screened annually to ensure that no hypertrophic cardiomyopathy is present.

As most Bengal cats today are several generations removed from the African leopard cat, they require no special care. They are simply larger "house cats."
