On a Bantam with +ve or chassis as the earth, you can connect the red wire directly to the chassis. However it is usually best to connect a wire directly from that same connection to the battery +ve. It is also advantageous to put a fuse in series with the live (-ve) connection from the battery to the wiring loom, just in case!
