CM may also be effective in treating several types of substance use disorder—for example, alcohol, opioids, marijuana, and stimulants—and is used to encourage or reinforce sobriety. ² This method provides material rewards as motivation for desirable behaviors, such as maintaining sobriety. ² A major benefit of CM is that it can result in a reduction in the two of the biggest treatment-related issues: dropping out and relapse. ²

Different Kinds of Therapy Used in Addiction Treatment

At the most basic level, group therapy is: “a form of psychotherapy that involves one or more therapists working with several people at the same time (Cherry, 2017).” It is usually a complement to individual therapy and sometimes medication as well, although it may be used as a stand-alone treatment for certain issues or problems.
