Author (person or organization) Year (or most recent date page created or revised) Title of the page or document; Publisher or the name of the sponsor of the page (if applicable) Date viewed (Day Month Year) URL <either full location details or just the main site details if the URL is too long>.

## Ultimate Guide to Harvard Referencing - Cite This For Me

To Harvard reference a website in text, put the title of the website and the year it was created in parentheses at the end of the quoted or paraphrased text. If there's no date, write "n.d." instead. For example, you would write something like " (Tourism Canada 2001)" or " (Tourism Canada n.d.)."
