2) Repair with fiberglass - Long strand fiberglass repair gel, unlike body filler, creates a structural repair that is nearly as strong as steel. Mix the gel and hardener, and press into the damaged area from behind. Check with the package, but it typically starts to harden in about 15 minutes and can be sanded in less than an hour.

Working in sections, apply the "varnish" with a sponge pad. Wipe in one direction only; do not "brush" the material. Allow it to dry for 5-10 minutes. The first coat of the restorative material smoothes over the oxidation in the fiberglass.

Using the utility knife, cut one layer of the fiberglass cloth to the size of the area needing to be repaired. You'll need to cut a number of other layers, each one smaller than the last, until you have enough layers to fill the area being repaired. Drill out the damaged fiberglass. In order for the epoxy repair material to attach to the fiberglass and material underneath it, you need to drill out the damaged material. Use a 1⁄4 inch (0.64 cm) drill bit and make a series of holes along the crack. This will open up the damaged area so that your epoxy can get inside and bond.

Measure, mix, and apply your resin Once your patch materials are prepared, pre—weigh the reinforcement schedule. You should target a 50:50 fiber to resin ratio for your repair, so once you have weighed your reinforcements, measure out the same weight of resin. Add catalyst or hardener and mix the resin as instructed.

Clean up any tools or spills with a solvent containing acetone before the material hardens. Acetone is great for cleaning up fiberglass because it's strong and evaporates quickly. Just be sure not to soak any portion of the fiberglass in acetone, and keep acetone away from any caulking, plastic, or rubber.

Sand or file the fiberglass filler before it fully cures. This will allow you to shape the filler while in the green state, which save a lot of time and sanding.
