Jesu dulcis memoria is a Christian hymn often attributed to Saint Bernard of Clairvaux. The name can refer either to the entire poem, which, depending on the manuscript, ranges from forty-two to fifty-three stanzas, or only the first part.

This anthem text, Jesu dulcis memoria, has inspired centuries of composers from Palestrina to Victoria and all the way to the 21 st Century. It is actually a hymn attributed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153), a French abbot and major reformer of Benedictine monasticism.

In the Roman liturgy, this hymn was appointed for the Feast of the Most Holy Name of Jesus, the second Sunday of Epiphany, beginning in 1722, and was divided into three short portions for Vespers (“Jesu dulcis memoria”), Matins (“Jesu, Rex admirabilis”), and Lauds (“Jesu, decus angelicum”). Jesu dulcis memoria=Jesu, the very thought of Thee. Usually the translation of the Roman Breviary text is followed here. (ii.) Jesu Rex admirabilis = O Jesu, King most wonderful. This is generally given from the translation of the Roman Breviary text (see below). It is distinguished from that by stanza ii., "Stay with us, Lord; and with Thy light."

Iesu, Dulcis Memoria is a celebrated 12th century hymn attributed to St. Bernard of Clairvaux (1090-1153), Doctor Mellifluus. The entire hymn has some 42 to 53 stanzas depending upon the manuscript. Parts of this hymn were used for the Feast of the Holy Name of Jesus, which was formerly celebrated on the Sunday between the Circumcision and Epiphany, or failing such a Sunday, on January 2.
