Its practice characterized Abraham (Gen 18:2-8) and the church leaders (1 Tim 3:2; Titus 1:8). And, as hospitality is an attribute of God, one finds its images in the biblical proclamation of the relationship between God and the covenant people.

As in the Old Testament, righteous behavior in the New Testament includes the practice of hospitality. One finds the commands to act hospitably in the context of other expressions of love (Rom 12:9-21, ; esp. vv. 13,20; Heb 13:1-3; 1 Peter 4:8-11; 3 John 5-8).

The word translated hospitality occurs six times in the New Testament - less frequently than such words as faith, love and holy. We are not to conclude from the infrequent use of the word that hospitality is not important. Christian hospitality is vital to the body of Christ.
