No questions regarding managed care arrangements were included in the NAMCS from 2001 through 2005. It is clear that managed care reimbursement schedules create a strong disincentive for the practice of psychotherapy by psychiatrists. In the Louisville area, for example, hourly reimbursement for a 50-minute examination and management session is roughly half what it would be for 15-minute medical management under Medicare, Medicaid, and some private carriers, Dr. Wright said.
