The first reference is one found in the Gospel accounts of Matthew, Mark and Luke in which Jesus said “Render unto Caesar the things that are Caesar’s and unto God the things that are God’s.” The second reference cited by readers is Romans 13, in which the Apostle Paul advocates submission to earthly rulers.

When Jesus said, “Render to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s,” He was drawing a sharp distinction between two kingdoms. There is a kingdom of this world, and Caesar holds power over it. But there is another kingdom, not of this world, and Jesus is King of that (John 18:36). Christians are part of both kingdoms, at least temporarily.
