Be sure to keep the slit as small as possible so it won't be visible when the repair is done. 2 Push down on the bubble to remove the air from the bubble.

To repair bubbles, moisten the area with a clean, damp cloth. Using a utility knife or sharp razor blade, slit the bubble. Avoid making a straight cut—a V-shaped slit or one that follows the wallpaper's pattern will conceal the cut and make gluing easier. With a narrow putty knife, force glue through the slit.

Use a specialty wallpaper syringe to squirt in a tiny bit of glue, then smooth gently with your roller. For tiny blisters, try using a pin rather than a knife to allow the air to escape. If the bubble is large however, you may have to make an "x" cut to get all the air out.

If the bubble really is just air, you can fix the problem with a glue-injecting syringe; it makes a less-conspicuous repair than cutting a slit. We bought ours, an Advance Equipment Co. model, at a Sherwin-Williams paint store for \$5.50. Fill the syringe with seam adhesive, push it directly into the bubble and press the plunger.

Fix Wallpaper Bubbles Greater Than an Inch Cut the letter X into the bubble with

either a utility knife or razor then pull each section slightly away from the wall. Take a small amount of wallpaper paste and carefully cover the undersides of each section made from the cut. Firmly place the paper back on the wall to its original shape.
