Sexual assault is a gendered crime; women are victimized at a higher rate (37 incidents per 1,000 women) than men (5 Endnote E per 1,000 men). As with other violent victimization, according to the 2014 GSS, young people aged 15-24 years have the highest rate of sexual assault (71 incidents per 1,000 population).
