The President's Budget. The congressional budget process begins each year with the president submitting a budget for the following fiscal year. The president's budget proposes spending levels for federal programs whose funding is determined annually (discretionary programs) and may recommend policy changes to ongoing programs that do not require annual appropriations (mandatory programs) and to the tax code.
