At low discount factors, private provision tends to result in lower levels of the public good relative to public provision. As patience increases, however, public provision results in lower levels of the public good than private provision. This occurs because higher levels of income redistribution are sustainable under public provision.

The private provision of public goods potentially suffers from the free rider problem described by Samuelson (1954 and 1955). Warr (1982), Roberts (1984) and Bergstrom, Blume, and Varian (1986) develop theoretical models where people only care about their consumption of private goods and the overall level of provision of public goods.
