The Twelve Apostles, (somebody sent forth/sent out) were men that, according to the Synoptic Gospels and Christian tradition, were chosen from among the disciples (students) of Jesus Christ for a mission. Judaism had an office known as apostle (אֲפוֹסְטוֹלוֹס). The Gospel of Mark states that Jesus Christ initially sent out these twelve in pairs , to towns in Galilee .
