The practice of assessment entails the collection of information in order to identify, analyze, evaluate, and address the problems, issues, and circumstances of clients in the counseling relationship. Assessment is used as a basis for identifying problems, planning interventions, evaluating and/or diagnosing clients, and informing clients and stakeholders.

CHAPTER 1 The Role of Assessment in Counseling

Assessment is the process by which counselors gather the information they need to form a holistic view of their clients and the problems with which they present. As a counselor, you will regularly assess your clients throughout the counseling process, especially in the early stages.
