Therefore, as you brake, change down gears before revs drop below 1000rpm so that you maintain the revs at around 2000rpm. Obviously, if you are coming to a stop, you'll let the revs drop lower than 1000rpm and will dip the clutch to prevent it stalling. You can 'block shift' gears, which means changing down more than one gear at a time.

How do you know when to change gear?

As you accelerate the engine will come to sound whiny and take on a higher pitch. This is because the engine is reaching its limits for the gear you are in. When you hear this you should change up. Remember: The low gears provide lots of acceleration but run out of steam before the vehicle is moving very quickly.

Shifting gears is going from one gear to another. You shift gears by sliding or clicking the shifter on the handlebars. This shifts the chain onto a different sized ring (or increases/decreases electric power output). Downshifting means going to a lower gear, and upshifting means going to a higher gear.

The process is fairly straightforward for everyday driving: when rev rise to 2500-3000rpm, change up a gear, and if they will drop below 1000-1500rpm change down a gear. If you need more acceleration then you wait when changing up a gear, but don't allow the car to go past the red line.

Upshift into higher gears. When you have achieved sufficient speed to justify shifting to a higher gear, roll off, (close) the throttle as you squeeze in the clutch. Place the toes of your left foot under the shift peg, lift the peg up as far as it will go. You can continue moving into higher gears by bumping the gear shift upwards more.

One way to remember where you are in the gears: When the chain is closer to the bike, front or rear, you're in your easier gears. As the chain shifts away from the bike (to the right), the gears get harder.

You must pedal while changing gears going uphill or anytime you need to change gears. The key to changing gears while cycling up a hill is to reduce the amount of tension on the chain when shifting to an easier gear. Bikes do not like to shift gears under heavy tension. Hesitate on the pedaling pressure but don't stop pedaling.

Use a harder gear on flats or if the wind is blowing from behind (a tailwind). When in doubt, shift before the terrain changes, especially on hills. Don't wait until you can feel the incline kick...

How to Shift Gears on a Bike | Bike Gears Explained

When a change in backlash is required, shims approximately 1 1/2 times the amount of change required are typically needed to bring the gears into spec. For example, if you need to change the backlash by .004-inch, shim(s) measuring .006-inch is a starting point.

Rearend Rehab: Why Pay Someone Else To Change Gears?

Usually when moving off from a stationary position you will select 1st gear and make your way through all the gears until 5th gear is reached. Occasionally you may find the need to go from 1st gear directly into 3rd gear. This is perfectly acceptable. Block changing down gears, from 5th to 3rd gear for example, is expected.
